Mother and father are a child's first gurus.






Saivism possesses a wealth of art and architecture.

Scriptures help us to know ourself, live a good life and love God"






Our holy men and women teach us yoga and ways of worship.

Daily Sadhana






All of life is sacred

Thus, Saivite art is sacred art, Saivite music is devotional music, and the Saivite's business is not only his livelihood, it is his service to man and God.




